#### a. The use of frozen semen for breeding and registration of Icelandic horses.

Virginia Lauridsen had been discussing the rules and regulations for breeding by embryo transfer and artificial insemination with frozen semen. Andrea Barber has volunteered to draft a set of rules for the USIHC. It turns out that some rules currently exist, but this is an opportunity to review and possibly revise these.

#### b. Diversity and inclusivity

Jeff Rose is following a podcast named "Young Black Equestrians" and suggested sponsoring a few episodes. The board was very supportive of the idea. Jeff will reach out to the podcast hosts and initiate a conversation with them. Upon further discussion of how to nurture and facilitate more diversity and inclusivity within the USIHC Virginia Lauridsen made the motion to form an educational outreach fund in support of initiatives reaching out to groups that are not normally given the opportunity to be exposed to and involved with horses. The fund would hold up to \$1000 in each budget year with funds available in \$100 increments. 2022 would be a pilot year for the fund. Jeff Rose seconded the motion and the board voted unanimously in favor.

# **Breeding Committee Meeting Minutes**

#### **January 12, 2022**

Members Present: Kristina Behringer, Heidi Benson Deb Cook, Lori Cretney, Sherry Hoover, Virginia Lauridsen (chair), Lucy Nold

Members Absent: Nikkisue Flanigan, Hazel Lynn, Susy Oliver

The breeding committee met via Zoom on Wednesday, January 12 at 8 pm Eastern time. Virginia Lauridsen called the meeting to order at 8:01 pm Eastern time.

The first order of business was a discussion of the scheduled events for 2022:

- 1. Breeding Assessment and seminar at Montaire Icelandics in Virginia May 20-22. There will be a breeding seminar on May 20, followed by an official assessment coupled with a "mock" assessment on May 21-22
- 2. Breeding Assessment at Harmony Icelandics in Iowa on August 30-31. This will be followed by Trainer Certification on September 1-2 and a Sport Show on September 3-4.

The committee next discussed having a Virtual Breeding seminar in the spring. Virginia has already contacted Heimer Gunnarson but has not heard back. If he is unavailable, she will contact other Breeding judges, perhaps Silke Feuchthofen or Elsa Albertsdottir. The committee then discussed possible topics; Breed Standards, Where are we going with breeding in the U.S.?, How does a high evaluation translate into a good riding horse?, What can we do as breeders in the U.S. to raise the quality and visibility of our breeding?

The committee decided to offer those as suggestions but perhaps the presenter has a relevant topic they would like to discuss. Suggested dates are April 2-3.

The next order of business was the budget request to the USIHC board. The committee agreed that \$1000 per evaluation and \$500 for the seminar is reasonable. Virginia will request \$2500 for events in 2022.

The committee then discussed having a requirement to serve on the Breeding Committee. Other committees, such as Sport, require that you attend a seminar. After discussion, the committee felt requiring attendance at a Breeding event (either in person or virtually) is a reasonable request. Kristina Behringer made a motion that committee members must attend one event, either in person or virtually, to serve on the committee. Deb Cook seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved by the committee.

Sherry Hoover then asked for an update on the stallion listing. Virginia shared with the committee that the stallion listing will be tied to farm listings on our website. Each farm listing will be granted one free stallion listing and a second stallion listing will be \$50. Stallion owners

will be permitted to include scores, photos, video and a written description of their stallion. There will also be a link on the website to all stallions – it will be an online stallion listing which can be easily changed.

Lucy Nold then shared with the committee that there will be an annual award given to the domestic bred horse with the highest scores in Green Horse Four Gait and Green Horse Tolt. The committee all felt this was a great idea to help domestic breeding.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:50 Eastern Time.

# Sport committee meeting, January 10, 2022

**Present:** Deb Cook, Lori Cretney, Will Covert, Asta Covert, Em Jacobs, Leslie Chambers, Lucy Nold, Carrie Brandt, Martin Nielsen, Jana Meyer (for item 4 only).

#### 1. Budget request 2022

We will be requesting funds for 18 Iceberg awards and \$2,000 for flagship funding.

#### 2. Rethinking policy 30A

Leslie Chambers proposed changing the flagship funding to become a source of funds to support judges traveling to shows. The idea is to encourage organizers to engage more than a single judge and thereby offer more opportunities for judges to gain experience judging. The committee was positive towards the idea and encouraged Leslie to develop it further over the coming year.

#### 3. Timing of virtual shows in 2022

The committee agreed that the spring show should have a deadline around the end of May or beginning of June. This deadline will work particularly well in World Championship years. The fall show should end by the end of October.

#### 4. Proposal from Jana Meyer and Alex Pregitzer

Jana and Alex had proposed developing some kind of introductory module describing how to make a virtual show video appropriately. The committee was very supportive of this proposal and discussed how to best approach it. The consensus was to develop a shorter video to make available to everyone. Then a more elaborate module could become part of the sport preparatory modules that the judges' task force is developing. Will also suggested the idea of a virtual riders' meeting at the launch of each virtual show, where some of these items could be covered as well. Leslie will try to incorporate a riders's meeting in her planning of the 2022 virtual shows and Jana and Alex will begin working on a short video with good and bad examples.

#### 5. Dressage-related FEIF tests

Kristina Behringer had asked about the possibility for adding dressage-related tests like dressage/freestyle and figures to shows. Will said that this is already done at some US shows and that the US judges should be educated to judge all these classes.
