- The focus of the bi-annual FEIF Youth Cup is on teamwork, sportsmanship, improved riding skills and cross-cultural friendships.
- FEIF Youth Cup is arranged every second year and consists of a week of intense training with respected instructors of international standing. The week ends in a competition with a range of youth classes on and off the oval track.
- Riders aged between 14 and 17 train and compete in international teams, with the aim of fostering friendship and an awareness of cultural difference. The language at all international FEIF events is English. (For any event with age limitation the January of the year of birth is valid for the age of the rider.)
- Usually, participants have some experience of competition riding. Most riders bring their own horses for the event, and for applicants from overseas, good rental horses are available.

Interested?

You must meet the following prerequisites:

- Be aged between 14 and 17 years old in July 2026 (born in 2009-2012)
- Be a member in good standing of the USIHC for at least one continuous year prior to the event. (membership from July 2025 or longer)
- Horses ridden in the United States for FYC try-outs must be registered in the United States at the time of the try out video. NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE GRANTED
- A major portion of the application involves an evaluation of riding skills. Applicants must register for the USIHC Fall Virtual show and compete in at least two classes, one tolt class (T1-Youth and/or T2-Youth) and one gait class (V1-Youth, and/or F1-Youth) Details on video requirements are on the virtual show webpage (icelandics.org). You may start making videos as early as June 1, 2025 (videos due by November 22nd 2025).

- Riders must earn a minimum score of 4.5 to be eligible for FYC.
